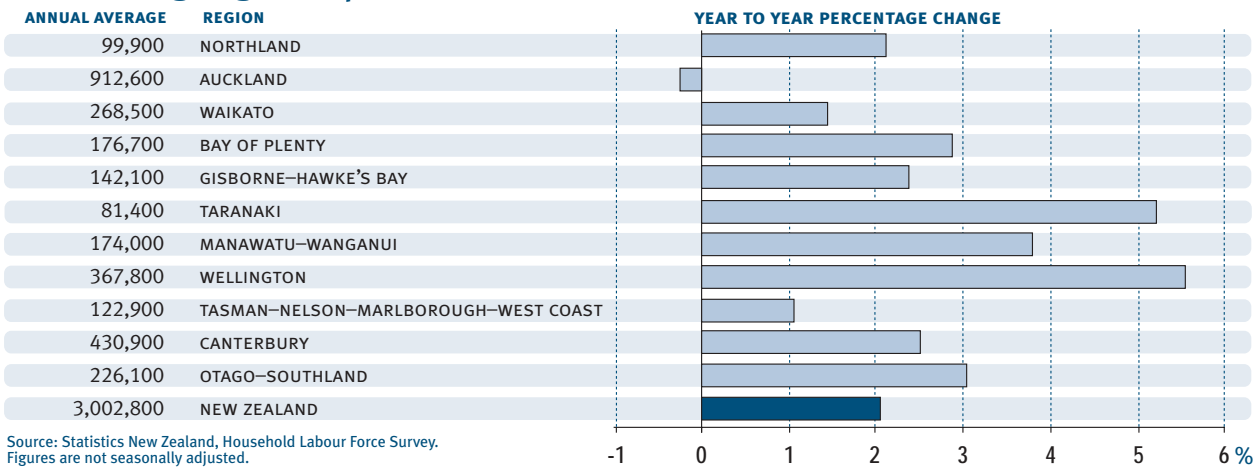


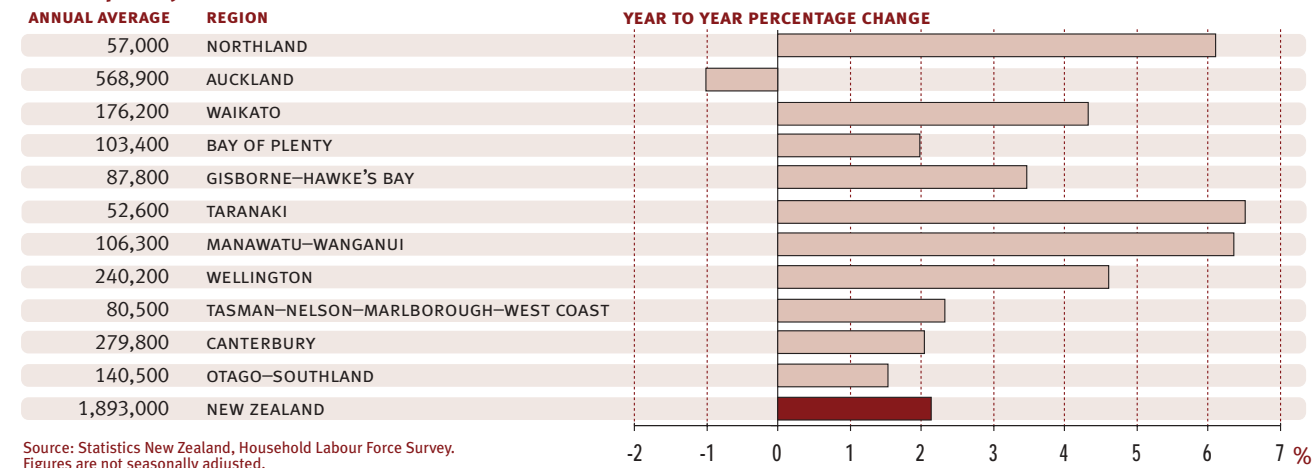

Working Age Population



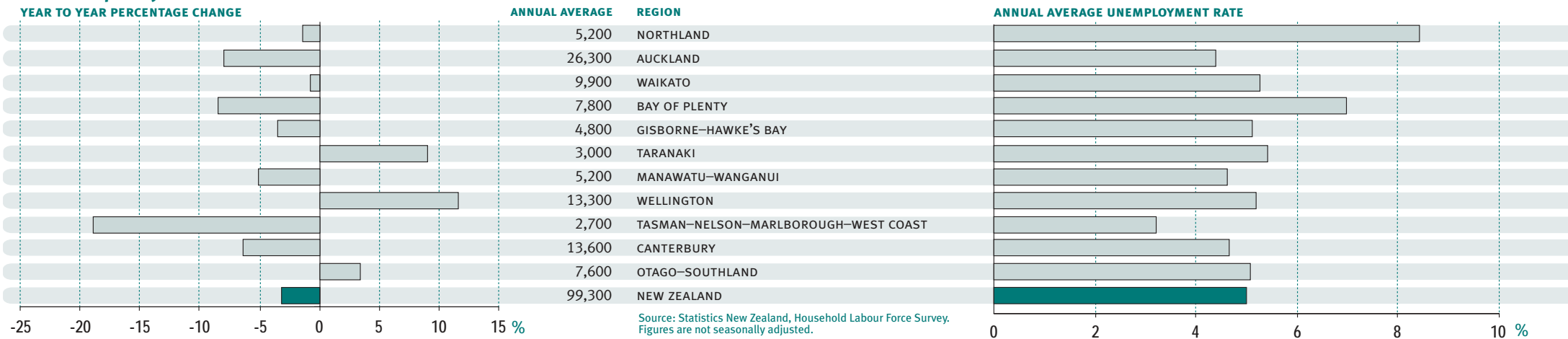

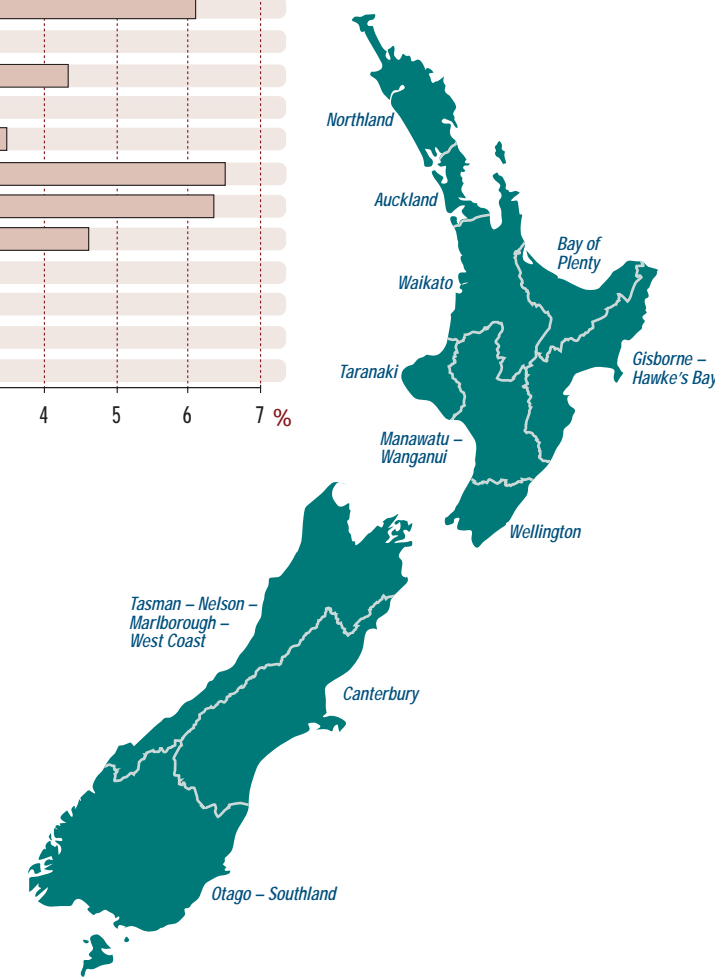

LABOUR MARKET TERMS

WORKING AGE POPULATION: those people aged 15 years and over.

EMPLOYMENT: the number of people who work at least one hour per week.

UNEMPLOYMENT: the number of people not in work, but who are available for, and actively seeking work.

UNEMPLOYMENT RATE: the proportion of the labour force that is unemployed.

ANNUAL AVERAGE: the average for a whole year.

YEAR TO YEAR PERCENTAGE CHANGE: the percentage change between the average for a whole year (for example the 12 months from July 2002 to June 2003) and the average for the previous year (the 12 months from July 2001 to June 2002).
